# Notes from the Service Officer

FWD from Department Service Officer:

#### Greetings!

Happy New Year to you and your family! I am pleased to announce that Pine Tree has officially launched a new project to address the social and legal factors that affect the health of veterans! The Maine Veteran Medical-Legal Clinic will allow Pine Tree to hold office hours at the Togus Medical Center. This new project is modeled on the Nationally recognized Medical-Legal collaboration model.

In October, Pine Tree hired attorney Krista Selnau to launch this project at the Maine VA Healthcare System. Read on to learn more.

#### What is a medical-legal collaboration?

"Tim," a Vietnam War veteran, was facing foreclosure on his home. He described an increase in anxiety and depression to his doctor at the VA, but didn't want medication. When Tim revealed the pending foreclosure and explained that he didn't know what to do. Tim's doctor, who had attended a medical-legal collaboration training just days earlier knew what to do - he sent Tim to the newly established medical-legal clinic for help.

Pine Tree Legal's new Medical-Legal clinic can help address the financial and housing stressors that impact Tim's health.

Pine Tree's new Medical-legal collaboration with the VA Maine Healthcare System provides a valuable one-stop shop for veterans facing a complex legal world. The project will also provide an opportunity for interdisciplinary collaboration to improve health outcomes.

Learn more about <u>medical-legal collaborations</u> nationally and how Inner City Law Center helps <u>homeless veterans</u> by partnering with the VA in West Los Angeles.

#### Know the Medical-Legal Clinic hours:

The Medical-Legal clinic at Togus Medical Center opened its doors in mid-November. Clinic hours are every Monday and Thursday from 8:30am - 1:00pm in Room 202, Building 206. Krista provides legal assistance to veterans during clinic hours, by appointment or walk-in. Krista also provides consults to healthcare staff during clinic hours.

In addition to the twice weekly clinic, the medical-legal collaboration will include monthly trainings on social determinants of health and civil legal needs for VA healthcare staff.
